The 2.1.5 release of the NeedToMeet Outlook Add-in resolves issues discovered since the release of version 2.1.4, and adds new features.

Release Notes 2.1.5

- When you change a Publish Access setting from Availability and Subject/Location back to Availability only, or vice-versa, previously published calendar items are now automatically updated to honor the new setting. (17398)
- When you make any change to *Selected Calendar Settings*, NeedToMeet now prompts you to **Save** or **Cancel** the change(s) before you can select a different calendar to configure. (17381)
- On the Calendar Settings screen, the Publish Data setting (for a selected calendar) no longer offers the Do Not Publish option. When you open the settings for a calendar that was previously set to Do Not Publish, NeedTo-Meet prompts you to choose one of: Update to Availability Only, Update the setting manually, or Remove this calendar altogether. - The *Calendar Settings* screen now displays a status note to indicate when a calendar sync is in progress, either by your clicking **Sync Now** or by the regular publishing interval. Also, the **Sync Now** button is now disabled when a calendar sync is in progress. (18086)



- The setting for **Append Personal URL to all NeedToMeet Messages** (on the *Account Settings* screen) is now preserved when the settings are saved and then reopened. (18261)
- This release corrects a typo in the *User Configuration* screen (in the *Configuration Wizard*), and one of the sentences on the same screen has been edited for clarity. (17629)
